

ARE YOU CONCERNED ABOUT SAFETY IN YOUR BUILDING?

Let us know if you've concerns around **structural issues, or the potential for fire spread**

This residential building is:

- ✓ 7 storeys + and/or 18m + in height

Therefore, the law requires us to provide a way for you to report any safety occurrences.

A safety occurrence is an incident involving, or a risk that could cause:

- ♦ the structural failure of the building
- ♦ the spread of fire or smoke in the building

It's something which could cause serious harm to people in, or around, the building.
